

By Winston S. Churchill

In 1939, just before the outbreak of war, Winston Churchill had completed the original draft of his great History. A *tour-de-force* of language and ideas, this massive work amply demonstrates the wisdom of awarding Sir Winston the Nobel Prize for Literature "for mastery in historical and biographical presentation."

This beautifully produced 4-volume set is cloth bound, with gold lettering and slipcase, it will be a rich addition to any library.

**Volume One:** The Birth of Britain. Churchill brilliantly recounts the story of the leadership of Alfred the Great, the invasion of the Danes, Romans and Normans, and the Wars of the Roses, concluding with the founding of the Tudor dynasty in 1485 on the eve of the discovery of America. 521pp.

**Volume Two:** The New World. A colorful portrayal of a galaxy of great personages and stirring events: Henry VIII, Mary Queen of Scots, Good Queen Bess and the defeat of the Armada and the sailing of the Mayflower (to mention just a few), ending with the escape of James II in 1688. 433pp.

Volume Three: The Age of Revolution, from 1688 to 1815. Churchill paints a vivid portrait of the momentous events of this memorable period and the people who played major parts—people like Marlborough, Napoleon, Nelson, Washington, Franklin, to name a few. 402pp.


**Volume Four:** The Great Democracies. The celebrated Prime Minister takes readers up to the turn of the century and the death of Queen Victoria, concentrating on the story of British-American relations, including a superb account of the American Civil War. 404pp.
